Texas Process Servers' Expo & Job Fair

TxAPPS invites professionals from across the United States to participate in the Texas Process Servers' Expo & Job Fair. Here's how you can get involved, as well as what you receive for your contribution.

The Texas Association of Professional Process Servers (TXAPPS) was formed in 2017 to promote and protect Texas Certified Process Servers and the process serving profession by:

- **Promoting legislation** to help process servers and the profession
- **Combating legislation** that may harm process servers and the profession
- Maintaining, promoting, and lobbying for **increased ethical standards** for the profession
- **Promoting Certified Process Servers** to the legal community and public
- **Promoting and sponsoring education** for Certified Process Servers in Texas

The Texas Process Servers' Expo & Job Fair is our way of serving this purpose and contributing to the process service profession.



EXPO Vendors>>>

TxAPPS invites vendors who sell products or services useful to process servers performing their duties to the courts. There is need for a variety of software and/or tools developed to optimize work flow. There is need for vendors to help maintain automobiles, i.e., tires, oil changes, mechanic shops. Process servers are constantly shopping insurance products for personal health insurance, as well as business and liability insurance.

As most process servers are self employed, or independent contractors, many are unaware and unfamiliar with how to plan for taxes, build a website, or advertise and grow their clientele. TxAPPS wants to partner with other organizations that bring business services and resources to the Texas Process Servers' Expo & Job Fair that promote and encourage all individual process servers to learn how to operate as a fully-functional business, regardless if they work alone or with a team.

In effort to build a continuing group of vendors for the EXPO, TxAPPS

has created a level of membership in our Association that allows vendors to support the Association and the EXPO throughout the year. **SUSTAINING MEMBERSHIP**, a \$500 bi-annual commitment, insures a prime-location booth each even year at the EXPO. Members receive standing invitations to attend all TxAPPS events, as well as recognition on our website and in the newsletter.

JOB FAIR Booths>>>

The EXPO provides an opportunity for larger process service companies and law firms to meet with certified process servers in a controlled environment where they can vet and interview independent contractors to help serve their papers across the Great State of Texas. \$50 / year **ASSOCIATE MEMBERSHIP** with TxAPPS is a way for process service companies outside of Texas to support TxAPPS and a JobFair booth at the EXPO is a great way to meet Texas process servers!

Law firms and paralegals can benefit from a booth at the JOB FAIR to find process servers and/

or process service firms to handle cases for them. TxAPPS' **PARTNERING MEMBERSHIP** is designed for those involved in the legal profession who are not process servers. The \$100 per year membership allows for serving on a committee, which can further the investment by working with TxAPPS more closely.

Educators>>>

Since 2014, the Judicial Branch Certification Commission has been providing oversight and guidance for certified process servers in Texas.

All certified process servers who renew their certification are required to provide evidence

that they have completed at least 4 hours of continuing education (C.E.) per year (or 8-hours of C.E. per each two-year certification period) as part of the renewal process. TxAPPS vows to support and promote all educators providing C.E. courses for Certified Process Servers, and encourages educators to participate in the Texas Process Servers' Expo by teaching a sample of the C.E. that they provide year-around.

All educators who teach at the EXPO will be given a booth in the Exhibitor Hall at no cost, in exchange for bringing the value of C.E. to process servers at the EXPO.
